WHAT DOES ALINE CARD BY ADP® DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number and employment information
- account balances and purchase history
- transaction history and account transactions

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons ALINE Card by ADP chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes — such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders, fraud and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

What we do

How does ALINE Card by ADP protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does ALINE Card by ADP collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you:

- open an account or provide account information
- pay your bills or give us your contact information
- make deposits or withdrawals from your account

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only:

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- ALINE Card by ADP does not share with our affiliates so they can market to you.

Nonaffiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- Nonaffiliates we share with can include service providers performing marketing services on our behalf.

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- ALINE Card by ADP does not jointly market.
